Group Disability Experience in a Post-COVID Context

Session Description: In this session, we'll explore survey data of industry morbidity trends for Short- and Long- Term Disability, in particular since the COVID pandemic. We will highlight the most significant changes since the pandemic and consider what may be driving them. In addition to reviewing industry data, we'll highlight topics on carrier's minds as they consider future outlook, including mental health and remote work impacts on experience.
